A professor in management at the Poznan University of Economics and Business (PUEB) in Poznan, Poland. His research interests include knowledge management, intellectual capital, school marketing, service design, education and innovation management, strategic management in public sector, entrepreneurship education. He was a Senior Fulbright Scholar at Sam Houston University, TX, USA and Marie Curie Research Fellow at the Centre for Social Innovation (zsi.at) in Vienna, Austria. He is the author of the first Polish Intellectual Capital Report in a Higher Education Institution (2004). He is an author of 15 books and over 70 research papers. Prof. Fazlagic has participated in numerous research projects including Innovation Report on the Polish Pharma Sector (2012), Service Design Summer School sponsored by the Santander Bank (2013), the Trust in Polish business sector (2015), "School for Innovators" commissioned by the Polish Ministry of Development (2017). His research project covered such topics as Intellectual Capital in Higher Education, regional development, internal communication and education. He was supervisor to 4 PhD theses, of which 2 in English and is currently working with 4 PhD students. He is active as a business consultant and trainer. He also supports the development of European head teachers by organizing seminars and conferences aimed at improving leadership skills and marketing competences in schools. He frequently appears on Polish national media commenting on the current state of the education. In the years 2011-2015 he was the Deputy Rector for Research and Development at Vistula University (vistula.edu.pl) in Warsaw. Apart from his full-time professorship at PUEB, he holds the position of the lead expert on education and learning at the state Institute for the National Institute for Local Government (nist.gov.pl) where he is responsible for preparing white papers and providing advice to government units, local governments and the Polish Parliament covering such issues as the development of creative industries, education policies. He is also the Director in The Programme Committee of Innovative Managers operated by the state agency for enterprise development PARP (parp.gov.pl).
